

3006. Alcoholic Beverage Policy

1. Policy

Consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on any property owned or managed by Mary E. Theler Community Center, except for single event, private parties (for example, a wedding) with a valid Banquet Permit or Special Occasion License or that are exempt from the requirement for a Banquet Permit (See <http://www.liq.wa.gov/publications/Cib2SpecialOccasionBrochure.pdf>).

Sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited. All beverages must be consumed on premises. Only beverages with an alcohol content less than 14 percent by volume will be allowed. Alcoholic beverages will be allowed only in Conferences Room 1 (Salmon Room) and 3 (Evergreen Room) and the exterior areas on the West side of the building in the immediate vicinity of the exterior doors to those rooms. Consumption is prohibited during school hours and 30 minutes before and after. Consumption is strictly prohibited in the parking lot or on the trails.

The event host will be required to demonstrate proof of liability insurance for the event (for example, a rider to homeowner insurance and will be responsible for assuring those serving liquor and all guests consuming liquor meet applicable Washington State laws and regulations relating to liquor consumption (See <http://www.liq.wa.gov/publications/OnPremiseslicensehandbook.pdf>)

The host must provide a copy of the proof of insurance and the liquor license, if applicable, to Theler Center not later than 10 days prior to the event.
