ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
MARY E. THELER COMMUNITY CENTER

The undersigned hereby executes the following Articles of Incorporation pursuant to the Washington Nonprofit Corporation Act, now codified as Chapter 24.03 of the Revised Code of Washington.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is and shall be Mary E. Theler Community Center.

ARTICLE II

Period of Duration

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes, within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), specifically for the operation and management of the Mary E. Theler Community Center exclusively for such enumerated purposes.

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ARTICLE IV

Limitation of Powers

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, trustee or officer of the corporation, or any private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by § 4942 of

the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in § 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in § 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

The corporation will not make any investment in such manner as to subject it to tax under § 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

The corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in § 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

#### ARTICLE V

##### Disposition of Assets on Dissolution

##### Or Final Liquidation

Upon dissolution or final liquidation of this corporation for any reason, its then remaining assets shall be distributed to the North Mason School District No. 403, an exempt organization under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future

United States Internal Revenue Law), or if no longer in existence, to any similarly exempt successor organization. No asset of any kind or nature whatsoever of this corporation shall be delivered to any person or organization whereby said person or organization may realize any profit or gain.

ARTICLE VI

Registered Office and Agent

The name of the registered agent of the corporation is Dr. Marie G. Pickel. The registered office address, which is also the address of the registered agent, is: Superintendent, North Mason School District No. 403, East 50 North Mason School Road, Belfair, Washington 98528.

Consent to Appointment as Registered Agent

Dr. Marie G. Pickel hereby consents to serve as registered agent, in the state of Washington, for the corporation herein named.
